



Top Tips

Travelling within the EU

1. To keep track of entry requirements and safety measures at your destination, **download the RE-OPEN EU APP** to your phone reopen.europa.eu/en
2. **Use “myTC” to store your documents** – talk to your Travel Counsellor about how they can help you with this.
3. **PRINT your DCC** and place it inside your passport, just in case your phone battery dies on the flight. It can also be uploaded to your **myTC App** or the **Irish Government Covid Tracker App**. If the name on your passport doesn't match the name on your DCC, you can call the Government Helpline 1800-807008.
4. Regardless of Vaccine, every country will require a **PASSENGER LOCATOR FORM** to be completed, do this online before you leave Ireland – **at least 2 days**, pre-departure.
5. Complete your online **IRISH Passenger Locator Form** within 72hrs of arrival back in Ireland.
6. Some destinations offer **Covid-19 Travel Assistance Insurance**, be sure to ask your Travel Counsellor – e.g. Andalucia Tourist Board and Canaries Tourist Board have this facility.
7. **Check your Drivers Licence** if you intend to hire a car, if it's expired and you are allowed the 'COVID Extension', then [click here](#) to find out what you need to do. You may need to bring authorisation letter from RSA ndls.rsa.ie/
8. **Check your passports** are still in date, most countries require 6 months validity from date of return. You can renew an Irish Passport easily on-line <https://www.dfa.ie/passportonline/>
9. Make sure you have **adequate travel insurance**.
10. It's best to check-in online as soon as you are allowed to do so. Make sure to leave plenty of time at your departure airport each way, due to extra health and safety measures.
